**Sermon Notes for January 8, 2023**

**“New Wine for the New Year”**

**Sermon Text:** Luke 5:33-39 (p. 1095); **Old Testament Text:** Psalm 126:1-6 (p. 657); **New Testament Text:** Ephesians 4:22-24 (p. 1244)

Read **Luke 5:27-39 (p.1095)** while listening to the sermon, then, answer the questions below.

1. In **Luke 5:33 (p. 1095)**, to whom did the word *they* refer?

By their questions in **Luke 5:30 & Luke 5:33**, what were *they* attempting to do?

2. Read **Luke 5:34 (p. 1095)**. In Jewish culture, what did the groom-to-be do immediately after becoming engaged to the woman who would become his wife?

What was the bride-to-be required to do to be married?

In **v. 34**, who is the bridegroom?

Why wouldn't guests at a Jewish wedding fast?

Why wouldn't Jesus's disciples fast while He was with them?

3. In **v. 35**, what is Jesus referring to when He says, “*when the bridegroom is taken from them?*”

4. In **v. 36**, what is Jesus saying people do with new garments?

5. Why would it be unwise to put new wine into old wineskins?

What is Jesus declaring about what He has brought to earth? (Did He bring old wine or new wine?)

6. What is Jesus saying in **Luke 5:39**?

7. What will you most remember from this message?
