Sermon Notes for January 14th

“Living on the Bread of Life”

Sermon Text: **John 6:35-40 (p. 1135)**; Old Testament Text: **Psalm 34:9-16 (p. 588)**; New Testament Text: **Hebrews 7:23-25 (p. 1280)**.

Read **John 6:35-40 (p. 1135)**; while listening to the sermon, then answer the questions below.

1. Read **John 6:35 (p. 1135)**.

What did Jesus call Himself in this passage?

What was Jesus saying about Himself through this title? (Try to list 3 things.)

What was Jesus declaring about Himself by using the “I AM” statement?

2. Read **John 6:36 (p. 1135)**.

To whom is Jesus primarily addressing this statement?

What did their failure to believe in Jesus reveal about them?

3. Read **John 6:37 (p. 1135)**.

What did Jesus mean when He said, “*All that the Father gives me will come to me?*”

What does that statement tell us must happen in our lives for us to be able to receive Jesus Christ as Lord of our lives?

According to this passage, how long will those who come to Jesus be with Him?

4. Read **Hebrews 7:23-25 (p. 1280)**.

What is the difference between the priests who used to serve in the temple and our High Priest Jesus Christ?

According to **Hebrews 7:25**, what essential thing does Jesus do for us to ensure we are saved completely (or as this passage says, *saved to the uttermost*)?

5. Read **John 6:38 (p. 1135)**.

According to this verse, from where did Jesus come?

What is Jesus trying to communicate to the religious authorities in this verse?

6. Read **John 6:39 (p. 1135)**.

What is Jesus communicating in this verse to everyone who believes in His name?

How should that truth make us feel?

7. Read **John 6:40 (p. 1135)**.

What should this verse mean to those who believe in Jesus Christ and have received Him as Lord of their lives?

What does this verse mean to you?

8. What will you remember most from this message?
