Search Committee Minutes 01/19/2020:

The committee met Sunday after worship. The final candidate, of the four finalists, finished his second interview on the 14th. Since then members have reviewed notes from interviews, listened to sermons from finalists and prayed about the upcoming decision. Discussion was held regarding the strengths and weakness of each candidate. The group felt it was imperative to proceed not on our own personal preferences, but to make the decision according to needs of congregation. The committee did agree on one candidate to recommend to the council for a visit.

The committee prepared the following proposed timeline (this was prepared under the guidance of LCMC).

- 1) Will report candidate's name to council for consideration.
- Conduct Background check on candidate. (standard procedure from LCMC)
- 3) Arrange a time for candidate and family to come to Platte for a weekend.
- 4) Have candidate meet with council (perhaps on Saturday).
- 5) Introduce candidate at Sunday worship and have him speak/preach.
- 6) After Sunday worship, have a fellowship time where members can met and greet candidate and his family.
- 7) Call committee will meet with candidate again after meet and greet for additional questions.
- 8) Hold congregational meeting and vote to see if congregation will pass the resolution to call candidate. (required by church constitution)
- 9) If congregation passes motion to call candidate, prepare a letter to call candidate.

The committee sincerely hopes the congregation will participate in this process physically and also spiritually by opening their ears, minds and hearts to new pastoral leadership.
