- 5. Read Malachi 3:11 (p.1021).

According to this verse, what will other nations say about Israel if the people do as God commanded them and bring their whole tithe into His house?

## 7. Read Malachi 3:13-15 (p.1021).

According to this passage, why were the Israelites grumbling against God and disobeying Him?

8. Read Malachi 3:16-18 (p.1021).

According to this passage, what will God do for those who fear Him and serve Him as He has commanded?
