# **Lenten Worship Service Times**

Weekly Men's breakfast and Bible study is **Saturday, March 2 at 7 AM** in the Fellowship Hall for breakfast and then in the Fireside Room, where we will watch a video from the Authentic Manhood 33 Series. Following the video, we will break into small groups, discuss the video, and pray with and for one another. **Children's Worship Sunday:** Please take note that the children's worship Sunday has been moved to Sunday March 10. The Sunday School students will be participating in the worship service through ushering, the Children's Sermon, reading Scripture, and special music.

On Sunday, March 17th, at 5:00 PM in the Trinity Lutheran Fellowship Hall, Neal Surasky of Chosen People Ministries will lead us through a Passover celebration as most Jews would celebrate it today. He will walk us through a Seder meal, explaining the significance of each dish and each cup of wine used, as the congregation samples them with him. Neal is a messianic Jew, a Jew who believes in Jesus Christ. As he walks us through the Seder meal, he will not only explain what the Jews believe about each part of the meal, he will also show how the meal points emphatically to Jesus Christ as the Messiah. Understanding the celebration of Passover and understanding Passover as a foreshadowing of what was coming through Jesus Christ dramatically enhances our understanding of the Messiah.

Following Neal's presentation, the congregation will do as a Jewish family does. Once we have completed the ceremonial celebration of Passover, we will eat a full-blown Passover banquet meal.
