"Man's Part in the Miracles of Jesus"

Sermon Text: John 2:1-11 (p. 1129); Old Testament Text: Psalms 91:1-8 (p. 631); New Testament Text: Colossians 3:1-4 (p. 1253).

Read John 2:1-11 (p. 1129) while listening to the sermon, then answer the questions below.

 Read John 2:1-2 (p. 1129). According to these two verses, list the wedding guests mentioned.

According to Pastor Dave, at what point in Jesus's ministry did this event occur?

What does it tell you about Jesus when you hear that He was invited to a wedding?

2. Read John 2:3-4 (p.1129).

What was wine a symbol of in the Old Testament?

Why was it such a problem for the newlyweds when the wine ran out?

Why did Jesus's mother, Mary, tell Jesus about this problem as soon as she heard about it?

According to verse 4 why was Jesus reluctant to get involved?

Read John 5:19 (p. 1133).

What do you think Jesus must have seen and/or heard from His Father before He got involved?

3. Read John 2:5 (p. 1129).

Why are Mary's instructions to the servants such good daily advice for us?

4. Read John 2:6-7 (p. 1129).

According to the information here, approximately how much water (or wine) would these six stone jars hold if you totaled it all up?

If you had been one of the servants commanded to do this work, how do you think you would have felt?

5. Read John 2:8 (p. 1129).

Why was the obedience of the servants so important to this miracle?

At what point did the water become wine?

6. Read John 2:9-10 (p. 1129).

How would you have felt if you had been the servant who had to take the wine to the master of the banquet? (Before the master of the banquet commented on how good the wine was.)

How would you have felt about your part in this after the master of the banquet raved about the quality of the wine?

7. Read John 2:11 (p.1129).

What does this miracle tell you about God's willingness to help us even in the small things of life?

What effect did this miracle have on His disciples?

How might you have missed out on a miracle in your life by failing to do what the Lord instructed you to do?
