Community Lenten Worship Services

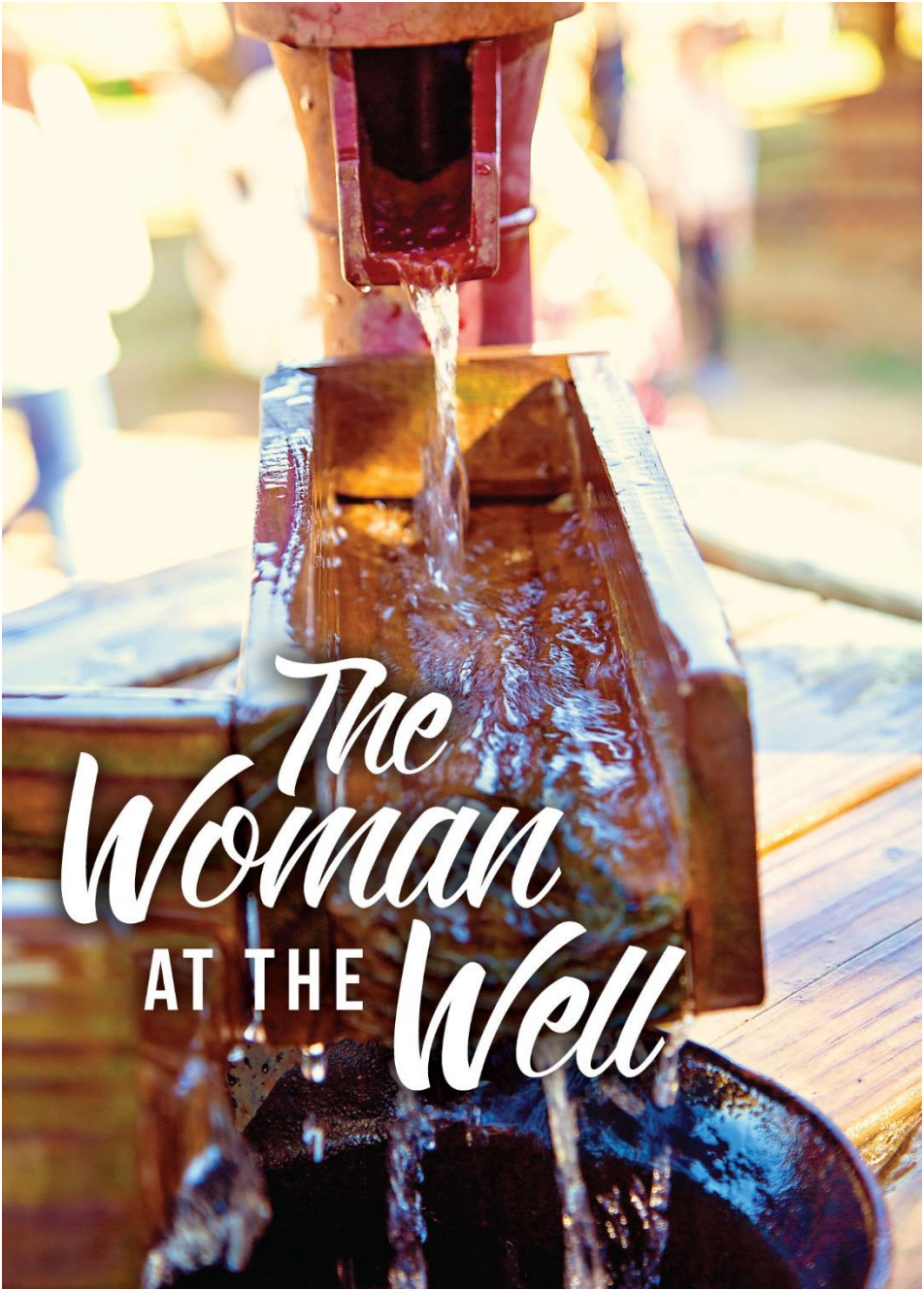
Sunday evenings at 7:00 PM
