

<u>Dakota Jubilee Home Concert</u>—The 22 men of Dakota Jubilee will provide an evening of Christian and patriotic music on Sunday, March 23rd, at the Platte First Reformed Church at 7 pm. A time of fellowship and goodies will follow! Everyone is welcome! A free-will offering will be accepted.

Our March Mission Offering is designated towards a feeding ministry overseen by Samaritan's Purse. The beauty of this program is that it is very flexible and allows donors to help people in a variety of ways. For instance, one part of the program provides immediate emergency food for people by providing up to a month's worth of corn, sorghum, lentils, rice, or other grains to feed them. There is another program for \$9/week, through which you can provide the goods necessary to bring a malnourished child back to health. There is another program, which for \$7/week, will supply a week's worth of hot meals for one student at school, and still another that for \$4/week will provide milk and nutrition for one student. Through other programs, one can donate baby chicks, lambs, goats, or calves, thereby giving people the gift of an ongoing food supply. There are still other programs through which one can donate seed, farm tools, draft animals, and fruit trees.

Please give generously to this ministry! At the end of the month, the Mission Board will decide how to divvy up the money to the various causes. They will also be responsible for putting up posters that inform the church exactly how each month's mission offering has been spent. If you have any questions, don't hesitate to ask Pastor Dave. She has had cysts like this in the past, which simply burst & go away. Doctors believe these will do the same. They will monitor her with ultrasounds every 6-8 weeks to make sure things are OK.

 have MS, but a milder version known as MOGAD. This typically responds
 well to medication and allows the person to lead a very normal life. Beau
 has lost 30 pounds, is eating wisely, & feels the best he's felt in years. Pray
