Platte Health Center is closely monitoring the COVID-19 situation. The facility continues to see outpatients and clinical patients at this time. We do, however, ask that you call the facility first and do not enter the facility prior to scheduling your appointments.

Visitors are limited to immediate family only and only one visitor per patient. During normal clinical hours, patients and visitors can use the main hospital entrance or the main clinic entrance for all clinic appointments. All other doors to the facility will remain locked.

- Fever over 100 degrees

- Shortness of breath
- Have traveled to a foreign country in the last 30 days or been exposed to someone with COVID-19
