4. How do you think you would have reacted if you had been the women?

How do you think you would have reacted if you had been one of His disciples?

Why do you think the disciples & women forgot that Jesus told them he must suffer at the hands of the religious leaders, be put to death, and be raised to life after 3 days?

Discussion Guide for Your Life Group Meeting

- At your Life Group meeting, first read Psalm 85:1-13 aloud. It can be helpful to have several people each read one verse from their Bible. This helps people feel involved and can also introduce some interesting discussion if several translations are used. After reading the passage discuss it. If you are having trouble stimulating discussion, you can try asking some of the following questions:
 - 1. What type of Psalm is this? (Who does it point to?)
 - 2. What is Israel's ongoing problem?
 - 3. What is the only solution to their problem & our problem?
 - 4. **Read Ps. 85:9-13** aloud again. Verse by verse, tell how each one reveals new truths about the Messiah.
- II. Next read **1 John 3:1-3**, utilizing several group members to each read one verse aloud. After reading the passage discuss it. If you are having trouble stimulating discussion, you can try asking some of the following questions:
 - 1. Have someone read **1 John 3:1** from the NIV. What kind imagery does the word *lavished* evoke?
 - 2. How much of God's love do you think God wants us to experience?
 - 3. What prevents us from experiencing such fullness on a regular basis?
 - 4. What title has God bestowed upon us in His great love?
 - 5. Why doesn't most of the world know us?
 - 6. According to **1 John 3:2**, what will happen to followers of Christ when He returns?
 - 7. What will all who have hope in Him seek to do with their lives?
