Sermon Notes for April 28th

“What We Are Praying When We Pray the Lord’s Prayer”

“Thy Kingdom Come”

Sermon Text: **Mark 1:14-15 (p. 1063) & Luke 11:14-23 (p. 1106)**; Old Testament Text: **Psalm 24:1-10 (p. 582)**; New Testament Text: **1 Corinthians 15:20-25 (p. 1222)**.

Read **Mark 1:14-15 (p. 1063) & Luke 11:14-23 (p. 1106)** while listening to the sermon, then answer the questions below.

1. Read **Mark 1:14-15 (p. 1063)**.

What did Jesus mean when He said *the kingdom of God is at hand*?

What two things did Jesus say we must do to receive the kingdom?

Why is the order of those two things so important?

2. Read **Luke 11:14 (p. 1106)**.

What important work was Jesus doing in this verse?

3. Read **Luke 11:15-16 (p. 1106)**.

How did some people claim that Jesus had cast out the demon from the mute man?

4. Read **Luke 11:17-18 (p. 1106)**.

How did Jesus quickly discredit those who accused Him of casting out demons by Beelzebul?

5. Read **Luke 11:19 (p. 1106)**.

When Jesus asks *by whom do your sons cast them out*, to whom is He referring?

6. Read **Luke 11:20 (p. 1106)**.

What is Jesus trying to get the people to understand in this verse?

Looking back at v. 18, and looking at v. 20, what two kingdoms does Jesus name?

7. Read **Luke 11:21-22 (p. 1106)**.

What is Jesus symbolically saying about Himself in these two verses?

8. Read **Luke 11:23 (p. 1106)**.

How could you restate this verse using the two kingdoms talked about in this passage?

Based on what Jesus said, are you a *scatterer* or a *gatherer*?

9. What will you most remember from this message?
