NEW HOPE UPDATE

The New Hope Board of Directors has voted to move ahead with summer programming! We will be offering camping ministry to children this summer.

After consultation with the SD Department of health and other local health officials, we believe summer camp can proceed while keeping children safe during this time. We will be initiating several measures to insure the wellbeing of the campers. Health screenings will take place at camp registration by a registered nurse. We will have a nurse on site every day during the camp week to check on the health and wellbeing of campers and staff. Temperatures will be taken daily. Personal hygiene and hand washing will be monitored regularly. The staff will be cleaning and disinfecting all living and eating spaces regularly. While this does not guarantee no infections will occur, we will do our best to minimalize the risk. Parents, we ask that you to weigh the risk verses the benefits of camp ministry for your own child. We recognize every family situation is different, and we trust parents to make wise and informed decisions concerning their children.

We do need to announce a few changes made to our summer schedule. All camps have been moved back 2 weeks from the previous schedule. The first Pioneer Camp will be the last 3 days of June, June 28-30. All other camps will be in July. These dates are posted on Facebook and on the camp website: **ww.NewHopeChristianCamp.org**

Also, we are limiting the number of campers for each camp to just 32 children. So please register soon if you want to guarantee your child a place at camp this summer.

We couldn't be more excited about this summer's theme, 2020 Vision: Seeing Christ Clearly! Children will be presented with truth: Truth of who Jesus is and what He has done for us. I hope you will consider registering your child or children for camp today. I know they will be blessed. And I know we too will be blessed to have them. And now may the steadfast love of God bless you and keep you during these crazy times.
