“Confirmed By the Holy Spirit”

Sermon Text: **Acts 2:1-13 (p. 1157)**; Old Testament Text: **Joel 2:28-32 (p. 968)**; Gospel Text: **Luke 24:44-49 (p. 669)**.

How many were gathered there on Pentecost? (See **Acts 1:15 p. 1157**)

Whom do we know were gathered there? (See **Acts 1:13-14 pp. 1156-1157**)

2. Read **Acts 2:2-4 (p. 1157)**.

What 3 signs accompanied the coming of the Holy Spirit?

3. Read **Acts 2:5-6 (p. 1157)**.

Why were there *devout Jews from every nation under heaven dwelling in Jerusalem at this time?*

What happened when these Jews heard the 120 speaking in their new languages?

Why were they bewildered at hearing this?

4. Read **Acts 2:7-8 (p. 1157)**.

What are these visitors from other countries finding so hard to believe?

5. Read **Acts 2:9-11 (p. 1157)**.
List the 15 different people groups named here.

What do they all say they hear in their own tongues?

6. Read **Acts 2:12(p. 1157)**.
What do all these people groups long to know?

7. Read **Acts 2:13 (p. 1157)**.
What did some mockers say was responsible for what they were hearing?

8. Read **Joel 2:28-32 (p. 968)**.
How did Peter use this passage to explain what was happening?
