TLC Search Committee Update:

The committee regrets to inform the congregation that the pastoral candidate that we were in the initial phases of the call process with, has withdrawn his name. This news was received on Tuesday and the committee met Thursday evening. Discussion was held on how to proceed, whether it is reevaluating previous candidates or exploring new options. The committee will meet again on Sunday, May 24 after the worship service or earlier if needed.

The New Hope Board of Directors has voted to move ahead with summer programming! After consultation with the SD Department of health and other local health officials, we believe summer camp can proceed while keeping children safe during this time. We do need to announce a few changes made to our summer schedule. All camps have been moved back 2 weeks from the previous schedule. The first Pioneer Camp will be the last 3 days of June, June 28-30. All other camps will be in July. Camp is being limited to 32 children per camp so register soon.
