## **Answering the Call: Our Church Supports Marion Medical Mission**

This month, our church's Mission Board voted to support the work of Marion Medical Mission - a ministry dedicated to providing clean, safe drinking water to the most remote villages in surrounding regions of sub-Saharan Africa.

Through generous financial gifts, we are joining hands with a mission that has helped install over 53,000 shallow wells since 1990, giving millions of people access to one of life's most basic needs: clean water.

In February, our congregation gave \$1,820.50 and in April we gave \$452. We have now given enough donations to fund over 7 wells! Each well only costs \$475 and 100% of donations go towards the designated purpose! We are praying we can give more in the month of June. As a church, we are called to serve not only within our walls or neighborhoods but also beyond our borders. By supporting Marion Medical Mission, we're living our Christ's call to "give a cup of cold water in His name" (Matthew 10:42).
