Confession & Forgiveness

P: How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!

**C: And that is what we are!**

P: Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known.

**C: But we know that when He appears, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.**

P: Everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure. This is how we know what love is:
