We have been able to give out water, snacks of peanuts, bandaids, new socks, and occasionally apples and something small for the kids like stickers or crayons and coloring pages. However, we haven't had the funds to do much more. We would like to be able to give sandwiches, bags of toiletries, groceries and meet other needs.
