**"The Four L's of Discipleship"**

Sermon 2 of 4

**"Learning"**

Sermon Text: **Luke 6:37-42 (p. 1097)**; Old Testament Text: **Proverbs 9:9-10 (p. 677)**; New Testament Text: **Colossians 1:9-10 (p. 1251)**.

Read **Luke 6:37-42 (p. 1097)** while listening to the sermon, then, answer the questions below.

1. Read **Luke 6:37-38**. What message is Jesus trying to get across to us in these two verses?

When Jesus says, *"Good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap. For with the measure you use it will be measured back to you,"* what is He trying to teach us about generosity?

2. Read **Luke 6:39**. What is Jesus teaching us in this parable?

Read **Matthew 15:12-14 (p. 1043)**. Who was Jesus calling blind guides in this passage?

The Pharisees were big on "keeping the law." What was it they were lacking?

3. Read **Luke 6:40**. Why is it so important for us to remember the first seven words of this verse?

When will we be fully trained as a disciple?

Who will we be like when we are fully trained?

4. Read **Luke 6:41-42**. Restate these two verses in your own words.

What is a hypocrite?

Why is it hypocritical of us to point out other peoples' sins to them?

5. What is Jesus trying to teach us about relationships in **Luke 6:37-42**?

6. What will you remember most from this message?
