7.	What did Jesus mean when He said, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. <sup>24</sup> God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth?"	
8.	Read <b>John 4:25.</b> Despite the woman's promiscuous ways, what did her statement here reveal about her?	
9.	Read <b>John 4:26.</b> How would you have felt if Jesus had spoken these words to you? Would you have believed Him?
