August's Mission Offering is designated for Marion Medical Mission. Thank you for your great generosity in contributing to the Marion Medical Mission Well Ministry this year. Our congregation has donated \$4715.00 this year so far. With our offerings we have been able to sponsor 9.9 wells!

What a difference these wells will make in the lives of those who receive them! Instead of drinking water laden with mosquito larvae, frog eggs, animal waste, and other pollutants, these people will now be able to drink water that compares favorably with our tap water. Wells are only constructed in the dry season from September to December. So, none of our donations have yet been used. We should begin getting reports of where our wells were built sometime in December.

We want to continue to help with this mission to sponsor more wells and hope to raise more funds to help support these villages with clean water. If you would like to donate, please make checks payable to Trinity Lutheran Church and note on check memo or in offering envelope "Mission Fund."
