Sermon Notes for August 27, 2023

"God Comes Down"

Sermon Text: **Exodus 19:16-25 (p. 77)**; New Testament Text: **1 Peter 5:6-11 (p. 1297)**; Gospel Text: **John 1:14-18 (p. 1127)**.

Read **Exodus 19:16-25 (p. 77)** while listening to the sermon, then answer the questions below.

1. Read **Exodus 19:16-19 (p.77)**. How would you have felt if you had been there to witness what is described in these four verses?

Do you think witnessing such an event would have made you more or less likely to obey God's commands? Explain.

How would this event have influenced your opinion of Moses?

2. God wanted Moses to warn the people not to force their way up the mountain. Why did Moses say that wouldn't be necessary? **(See v. 23.)**

If you had been there to witness this event, do you think you would have tried to force your way up the mountain? Why or why not?

3. Pastor Dave compared this event to what it will be like when Jesus returns. What did he mean by that?

Despite the awe-inspiring, terrifying things that will accompany Jesus's return, why should we be able to have peace?

4. Why do you think God wanted Aaron to accompany Moses up the mountain?

How would you have felt if you had been there, and God had commanded you to come up the mountain with Moses?

5. What will you remember most from this message?
