**Sermon Notes for September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

**“The People Rebel”**

Sermon Text: **Exodus 32:7-24 (p. 91)**; New Testament Text: **Ephesians 1:15-23 (p. 1241-1242)**;  
Gospel Text: **Matthew 5:13-16 (p. 1029)**.

Read **Exodus 32:7-24 (p. 91)** while listening to the sermon, then answer the questions below.

1. Read **Exodus 32:7 (p. 91)**. The Israelites had agreed on two different occasions to obey God's commands. How would you have felt if you had been Moses and heard what God spoke to him in v. 7?
  
2. Read **Exodus 32:8 (p. 91-92)**. How do you think God must have felt when He looked down and saw that the Israelites were worshipping an idol?
  
3. Read **Exodus 32:9-10 (p. 92)**. What did God mean when He called the Israelites stiff-necked people?

According to v. 10, what did God intend to do?

4. Read **Exodus 32:11-13 (p. 92)**. Give two reasons Moses didn't want God to destroy the Israelites.
  
5. Read **Exodus 32:14 (p. 92)**. How did God respond to Moses's appeal for mercy?

6. Read **Exodus 32:15-16 (p. 92)**. Knowing what you know about Moses, what do you think he thought about the stone tablets he carried down the mountain.
  
7. Read **Exodus 32:17-18 (p. 92)**. To what did Joshua attribute the noise coming from the Israelite camp?

To what did Moses rightly attribute the noise?

8. Read **Exodus 32:19-20 (p. 92)**. What two things did Moses do when he came into camp and saw the Israelites worshipping the golden calf?
  
9. Read **Exodus 32:21-24 (p. 92)**. What three things did Aaron blame for the creation of the golden calf?
  
10. What will you remember most from this message?
