What are two ways Paul's statement *caught in any transgression* might be interpreted?

Who does Paul say should *restore those caught in any transgression*?

How are we to restore these people?

2. Read **Galatians 6:2 (p. 1239)**.

What are some ways we might *bear one another's burdens*?

3. Read **Galatians 6:3 (p. 1239)**.

Explain in your own words what Paul is saying in this verse.

4. Read **Galatians 6:4-5 (p. 1239)**.

What is Paul talking about in these two verses?

What *is the load each of us must bear*?

5. Read **Galatians 6:6 (p. 1239)**.

What is it that Paul wants *the one who is taught the word to share with the one who teaches?*

6. Read **Galatians 6:7 (p. 1239)**.

In your own words, tell me what Paul is saying here?

7. Read **Galatians 6:8 (pp. 1239-1240)**.

To what two choices in life are we always sowing?

Tell what each choice yields for a harvest?

8. Read **Galatians 6:9-10 (p. 1240)**.

Why is it so important for us to continue to *do good?*

9. What will you most remember from this message?
