Sermon Notes for October 2, 2022

“God’s Miraculous Provision”

Sermon Text: 1 Kings 17:7-24 (page 379); **Old Testament Text:** Psalm 121:1-8; **New Testament Text:** 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Open your pew Bible to 1 Kings 17:7-24 (page 379), and as you listen to the sermon, answer the questions below.

1. Why was God so angry with King Ahab? (See 1 Kings 16:30-33 p. 379.)
2. What did God have Elijah declare to King Ahab? (See 1 Kings 17:1 p.379.)
3. What was it about the idol Baal that made God’s punishment for King Ahab such an appropriate one? (Listen to sermon.)
4. Where did God initially hide Elijah and how did He provide food for him there? (See 1 Kings 17:2-6.)
5. After the brook dried up, where did God command Elijah to go? (See 1 Kings 17:9.)

6. Why was this an unusual place for God to hide Elijah? (Hint: Who ruled as king over this place & what did they manufacture in this city?)

7. What did Elijah ask the widow to bring him? (See 1 Kings 17:10-11.)

Why was this such an extravagant request? (See 1 Kings 17:12.)

What did Elijah tell the widow God would do if she would only share her food with Elijah? (See 1 Kings 17:14.)

8. Why did the widow think her son had died? (See 1 Kings 17:18)

9. How did God use Elijah to bring the widow's son back to life? (See 1 Kings 17:19-21.)

10. How did the widow react to Elijah raising her son from the dead? (See 1 Kings 17:24.)

11. What will you remember about God from this passage of scripture & this message?
