The Alpha course began August 28th at Trinity and has been meeting Sunday evenings at 6:30 ever since. Twenty-one people signed up for the course and have been enjoying a home-cooked meal shared in the company of a small group family. Following the meal, participants watch a video together, then, go to their breakout rooms to discuss the video in their small group. **Sixteen Alpha participants will join Pastor Dave at New Hope Christian Camp October 8 & 9 for the Alpha Retreat Weekend.** The weekend is devoted to learning about the Holy Spirit, spiritual gifts, and prayer. It is a fun time for growing closer to God and closer to one another. The current course will end November 6. We anticipate running another course sometime in late winter or early spring. At the end of this session, ask current participants what they thought of the course. Alpha may be just what you were looking for.

Our **Mission Opportunity for the month of October is Kingdom Boundaries Prison Aftercare** located in Sioux Falls. KBPA is a faith-based 501c3 ministry whose vision is to reduce recidivism by fostering Christian character one person at a time. (Recidivism is the return rate of prisoners going back to prison.) KBPA builds relationships with prisoners through an inmate mentoring program. Upon the prisoner's release from prison, his mentor is there to meet him and help him find his way outside of prison. KBPA's Prison Aftercare has five core components: mentoring, education, counseling and spiritual guidance, housing support, and assistance in finding a job. KBPA currently provides transitional housing for 21 men in three buildings. Participants in the program are not given a free ride. They pay rent monthly and their portion of the utilities. KBPA has purchased land in Sioux Falls and is in the process of building a new facility that could house 58 men and 21 women as well as host their offices and classrooms. To donate, please write a check to Trinity with KBPA in the memo, or place cash in a sealed envelope indicating the amount you wish to go to this mission. **This offering will be taken Sunday, October 16th.**
