On October 17 at 7:00 pm at Lyric Theater there will be a Film Adaptation of the Best-Selling Book "Letter to the American Church" written by Eric Metaxas. The film lays out the parallels between early 1930's Nazi Germany and other totalitarian regimes with what is happening in America today and how the church has been mostly silent facing this evil. Eric and several leading conservative voices of our time, explain how cultural Marxism has taken over America, including the church. This film is a wake-up call to the church to stand up and speak out against the evil that is manifesting in our country.

Weekly Men's breakfast and Bible study meets this **Saturday, October 19 at 7 AM** in the Fellowship Hall for breakfast and then in the Fireside Room to watch the video, break into small groups, discuss the video, and pray with and for one another.

Hurricane Helene left a path of devastation across the Southeast, from the coast of Florida to the mountains of North Carolina. Samaritan's Purse U.S. Disaster Relief staff members are on the ground in five locations. They are partnering with local churches to field teams who are helping hurting homeowners in Jesus' Name. Volunteers are assisting to mud out homes, cut downed trees, tarp roofs, and remove debris to help families get through this historic crisis. Please pray for all communities along the path of this massive storm as they recover.
