Read 2 Peter 1:3 (p. 1298).
Whose *divine power* is Peter talking about in this verse?

How is that *divine power* received in the life of a believer?

How do we access this power and grow in it?

2. Read **2 Peter 1:4 (p. 298).** Through what has Jesus given us *His very great and precious promises?*

What does it mean to *participate in the divine nature*?

How could living this way help us to *escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires*?

3. Read 2 Peter 1:5-7 (p. 298).

What 7 things does Peter instruct us to add to our faith?

From what did Pr. Dave say we are able to receive 3 of these virtues?

Explain how we can add these 7 things to our faith without wearing ourselves out?

4. Read 2 Peter 1:8 (p. 298).

How could doing what Peter tells us to do make us more effective witnesses for Jesus?

Read 2 Peter 1:9 (p. 298).
Explain how failing to do what Peter instructs us to do in this passage could make us *nearsighted and blind*.

6. Read 2 Peter 1:10-11 (p. 298).Is Peter saying here that we must earn our way into heaven?

What is he saying in these two verses?
