## "Humble Beginnings"

Sermon Text: Isaiah 11:1-5 (p. 732); New Testament Text: Revelation 19:11-16 (p. 1325); Gospel Text: John 14:6 (p. 1146)

Read Isaiah 11:1-5 (p. 732) above while listening to the sermon, then, answer the questions below.

1. Read **Isaiah 11:1.** From the sermon, what did Pastor Dave say the stump symbolized about the kingdoms of Judah & Israel?

- 3. Read Isaiah 11:3 (p. 732). What does it mean when Isaiah says *his delight shall be in the fear of the Lord*?

4. Read **Isaiah 11:4.** What is God looking for in His people in the way they treat the poor , the meek, and the hurting?

What did Jesus do in His ministry on earth to model for us how we are to treat those society has forgotten?

5. Read **Isaiah 11:5.** Why should it be important to us that the Messiah wears the belts of righteousness & faithfulness?

6. What will you remember most from this message & how will that help you in your relationship with the Lord?
