Sermon Notes for December 31st

"Living in the Newness of Christ"

Sermon Text: John 1:9-18 (p. 1127); Old Testament Text: Ezekiel 36:26-27 (p. 918); New Testament Text: Romans 8:9-11 (p. 1201).

Read John 1:9-18 (p. 1127); while listening to the sermon, then answer the questions below.

1. Read John 1:9 (p. 1127). To whom did Jesus come to give light?

What determines if a person walks in the light of Christ or not?

What did Jesus call Himself in John 8:12 (p. 1137)?

Read John 1:10 (p. 1127).
What does John mean when he says *the world was made through him?* (Hint: See John 1:3 (p. 1127).

Why did so few people understand who Jesus really was?

Read John 1:11 (p. 1127).
When John says, "*He came to His own*." To whom is John referring?

What did John mean when he said, "His own people did not receive him?"

4. Read John 1:12-13 (p. 1127).Tell me <u>in your own words</u> what these two verses mean.

What is the new identity we receive when we receive Jesus Christ as the Lord of our life?

5. Read John 1:14 (p. 1127).

By referring to Jesus as *the Word*, what was John implying about Him?

Pr. Dave said the Greek word John used to tell us Jesus *dwelt among us* meant tent or tabernacle. With what would the Jews have associated the tabernacle?

With what would the tabernacle have been filled?

With what 2 things did John say Jesus was filled when He came to the earth?

6. Read John 1:15 (p. 1127).

To what was John the Baptist referring when he said Jesus came after me?

What did he mean when he said, "he ranks before me, because he was before me?"

7. Read John 1:16 (p. 1127).

From whom did Jesus receive his fullness? (Hint: See Colossians 1:19 (p. 1252.)

Why is it important for us to remember *we have all received grace upon grace* from Jesus?

8. Read John 1:17 (p. 1127).

What is John telling us here about the covenant that came through Jesus?

- 9. Read John 1:18 (p. 1127). John tells us in this verse why Jesus came to earth. What was the reason?
- 10. What will you remember most from this lesson?
