Men's Retreat



Make this craft to remember God's many blessings. What you need: • Small stones • Permanent markers • Foil pan and cooking spray • Drop cloth • Gloves • Quick-set concrete (and adult help) • Bucket and paint stirrer What you do: 1. After reflecting on the past year, use markers to decorate stones with

- memorable words, dates and drawings. 2. Spray pan with cooking
- 2. Spray pan with cooking spray. Set pan outside on a drop cloth.
- 3. Wearing gloves, mix concrete in a bucket, according to instructions.
- 4. Pour concrete into pan. Smooth top with paint stirrer.
- 5. Press in stones, handprints and other decorations.
- 6. Let dry completely. Remove from pan.
- 7. Place the stepping-stone outside as a reminder of God's continued goodness.

TLC Search Committee Update 12/15/19:

Committee member Jonna DeHaan gave a verbal update to the congregation on 12/15. The update included the following information: The Search Committee has been meeting and/or communicating weekly for almost a year now. The committee conducted a survey, interviewed interim candidates and suggested hiring Pastor Ron. The council granted a 9 month contract (thru March) to Pastor Ron with the option of a month to month extension if needed. Since July the committee has filtered through and researched almost 15 or more candidates. Five candidates were initially interviewed and all were offered a second interview to be conducted in person. All five accepted the offer. As of 12/15, three candidates have come to Trinity for another 2 hour interview along with a tour of the church, parsonage and community. The other two remaining candidates are tentatively scheduled for their second interview in mid-January. After completing those interviews, the committee will reevaluate candidates and proceed. If you have any feedback or questions you are welcome to contact any committee member.

The committee asks for the congregation's continued patience and prayers throughout this process. Our prayer is that all members open their minds and hearts to the candidates and the process so that we will be able to discern the direction God is leading His church here at Trinity.
